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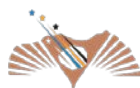

Assessment Information

Navajo Nation Seal of Bilingual Proficiency Assessment is for graduating High School seniors who can speak Diné Language. High School seniors can register to take the assessment 10 days PRIOR to assessment date.

FREE REGISTRATION!

!!NO FEES!!

Students must meet the assessment deadline of no later than the end of March of each year. No exceptions!

All testing sessions will be scheduled through Zoom for school year 2022-2023.



Criteria:

- Schools must register on-line at the Department of Diné Education at least 10 days prior to testing date.
- Seniors have the option of retaking the assessment.
- An official letter from the Navajo Nation with the test result will be sent to the student's respective school within 15 working days.
- School official(s) will notify students of test results.
- Only those students who successfully pass the proficiency assessment will be recommended by their school official(s) to the State.
